Diagnosis: malignant melanoma

History and side effects since last visit: Jack has been doing well. Good appetite and energy. No vomiting/diarrhea. No coughing/exercise intolerance.

Current diet: Ketogenic diet raw

Current medications: Cas Options BID, AHCC 750mg BID, Beta Glucan 500mg BID, Decarboxylated Hemp CBD 750-900mg BID, Neoplasene 22m/kg BID

Medication refill requests: None

Physical Exam:

T 101.7 P 130 R pant/0 p/1
Weight: 56.6 lbs (25.72 kgs) (0.87 m2)
Previous weight: 57.6 lbs

Heart auscults with no obvious murmur or arrhythmia, pulses are regular, strong, synchronous

Lungs sound clear on auscultation, no referred upper airway sounds.

Abdomen not painful, no masses or fluid found

Musculoskeletal: ambulatory x 4, no discomfort on gentle palpation of legs, no lameness.

Neurological: bright, alert and responsive, no cranial nerve deficits

Eyes/Ears/Nose/Throat: pink, moist mm, CRT<2, normal aging changes, some pigment change
no thickness to the areas (such a good boy not to bite me!!)

Peripheral Lymph nodes: all were small and soft

Integument & Hydration: within normal limits

Diagnostics:

Radiographs: clear for any metastasis

Assessment and Plan: Jack looks great today and still shows no sign of tumor regrowth or metastasis. We discussed that he is exercising so much that you will probably have to increase the amount of food again - a problem he will not mind having. You could also consider adding

some treats or fat to increase the calories. The diet he is on is relatively low in calories for such an athletic dog.

Treatments given today: none

Medications to give at home: continue as you have been

Diet: Jack should continue with his very excellent diet

Exercise: Jack should continue with his normal routine, and enjoy his dock diving as long as he can.

Please continue to give Jack his tick preventative.

Please schedule your next appointment in 1 to 3 months for recheck of his mouth and lymph nodes. He would be due for his next melanoma vaccine in September.
